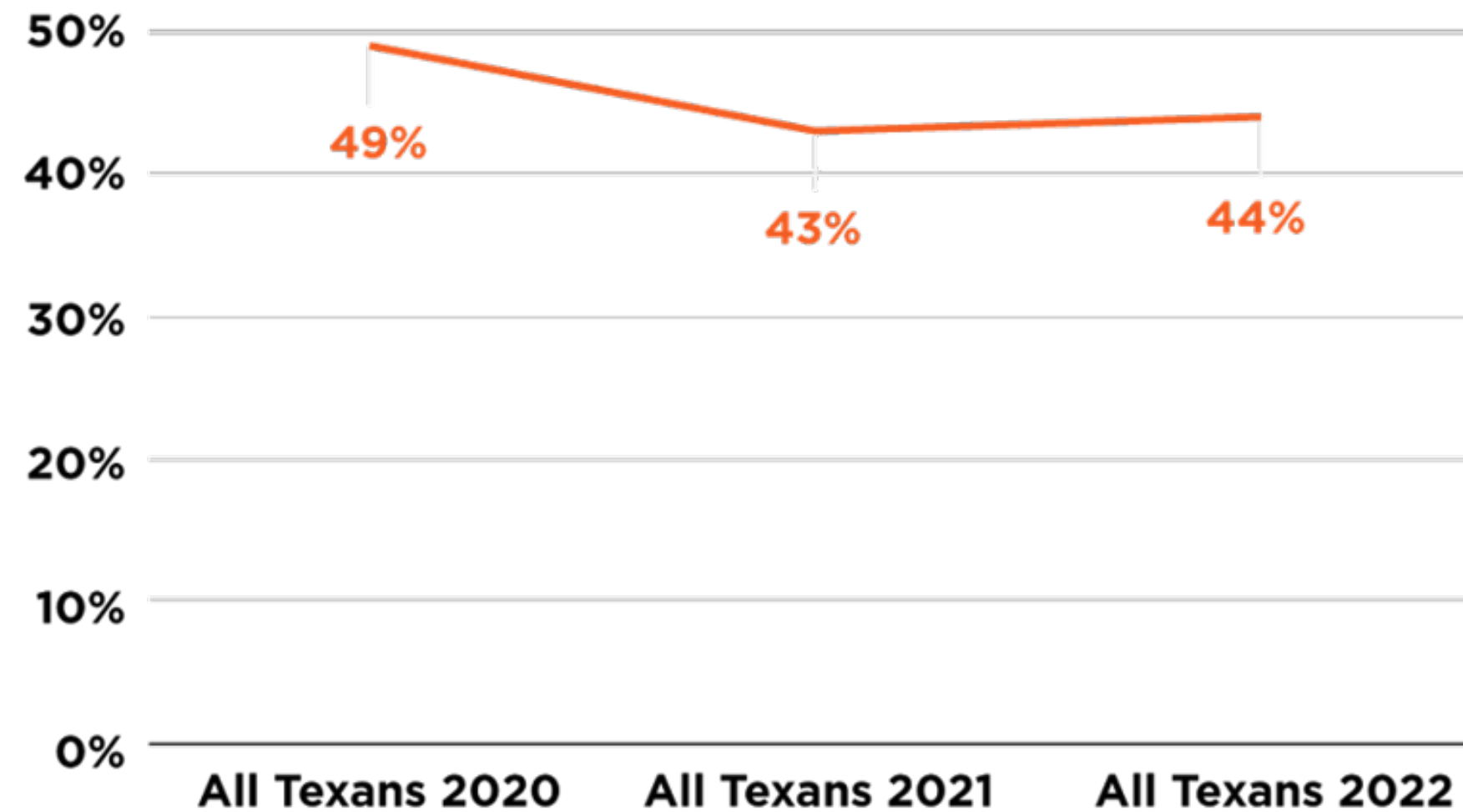

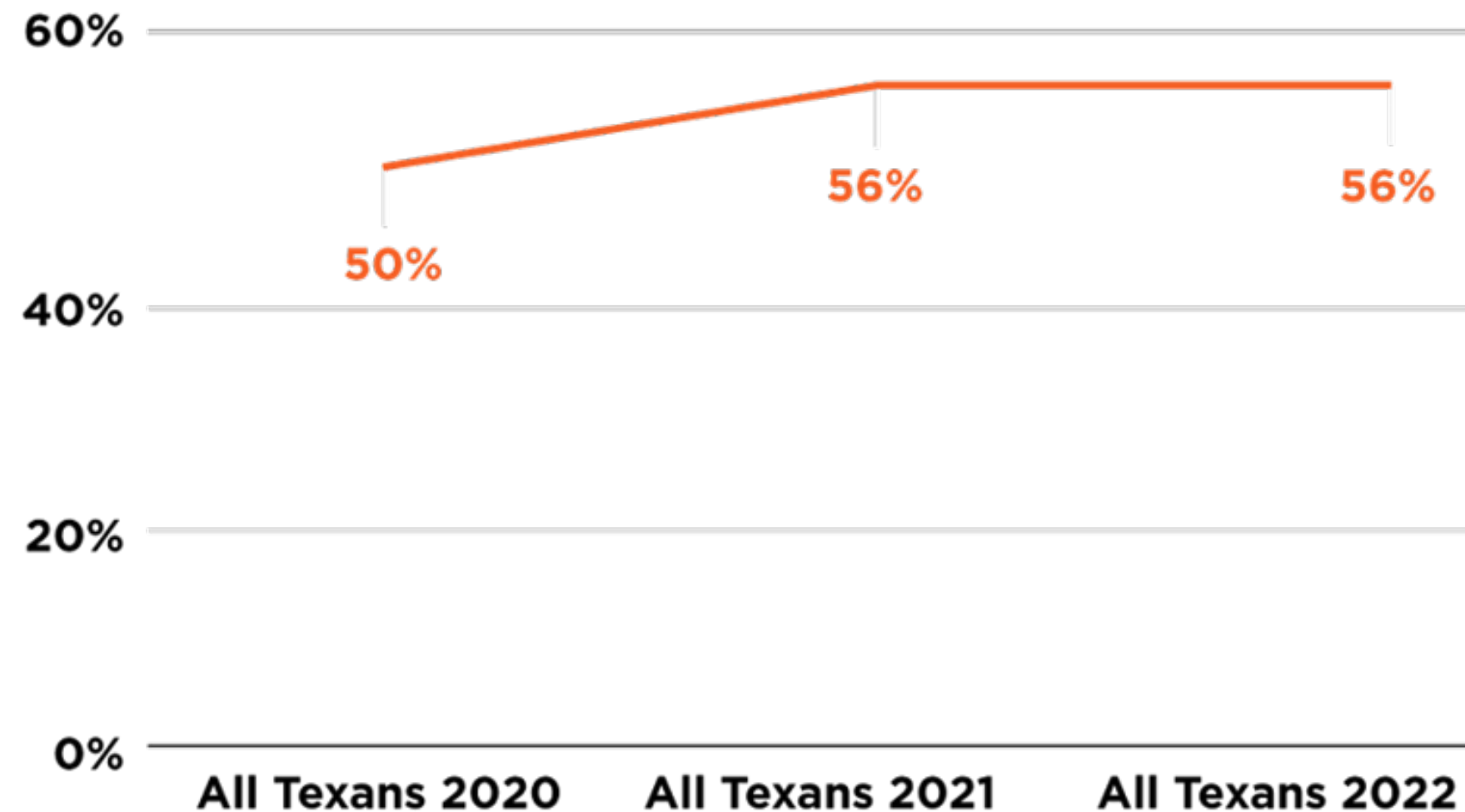


Texans' Confidence in STAAR Drops



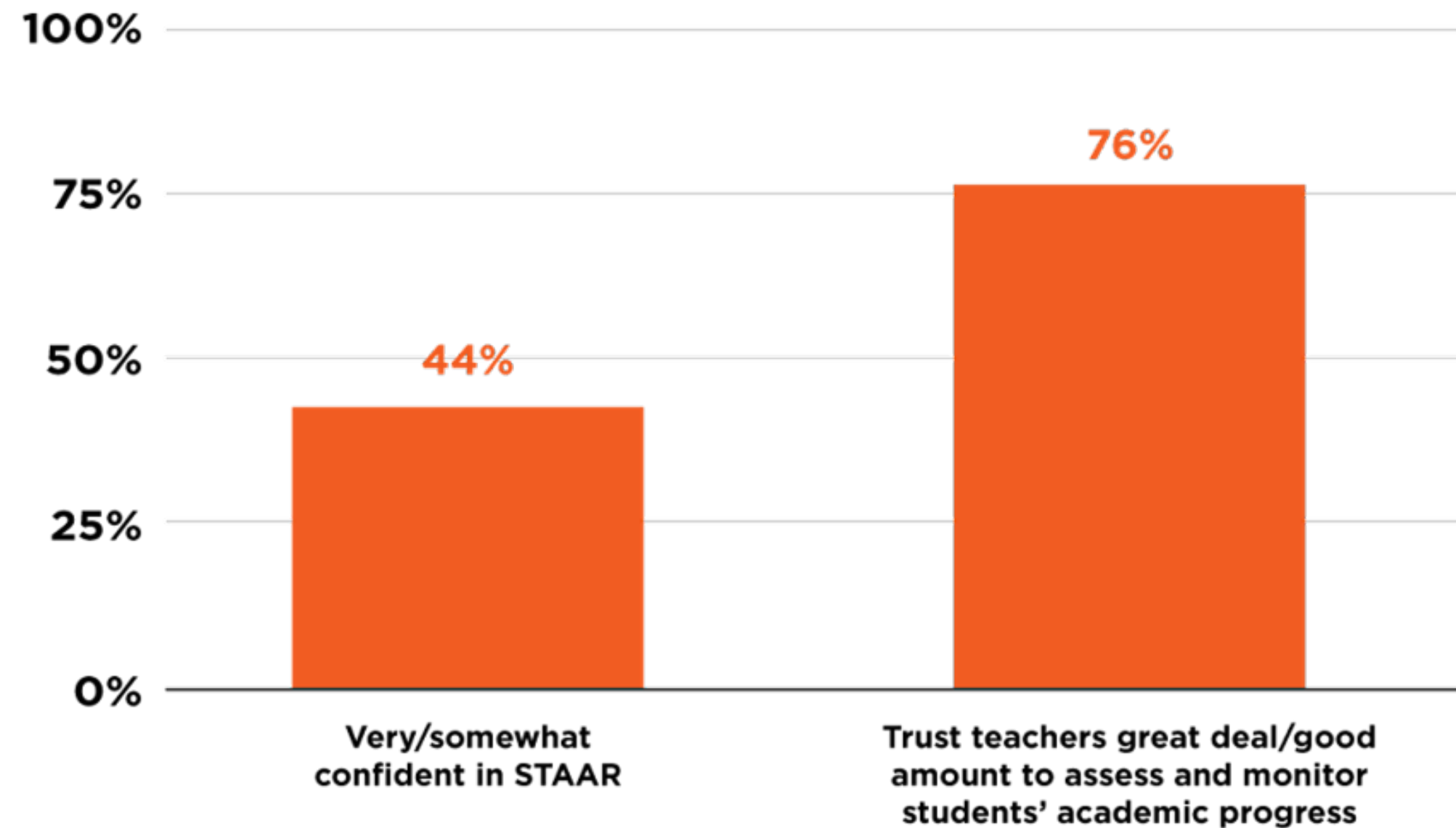

Skepticism in STAAR Increases Over Time



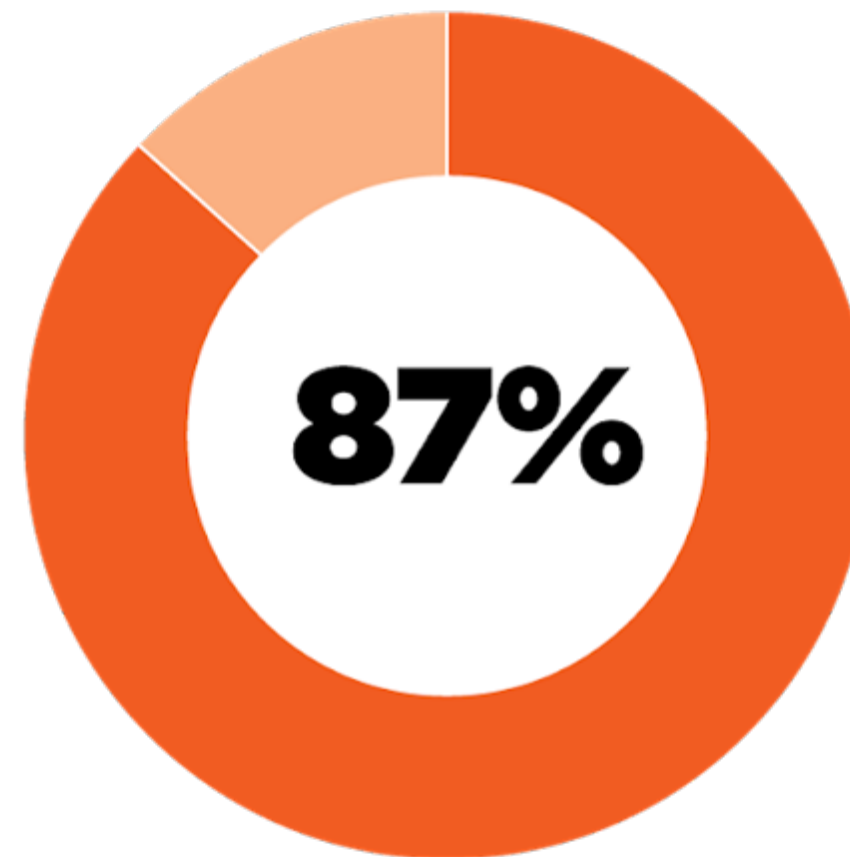

Only 1% of Texas Teachers Report They are Very Confident in STAAR

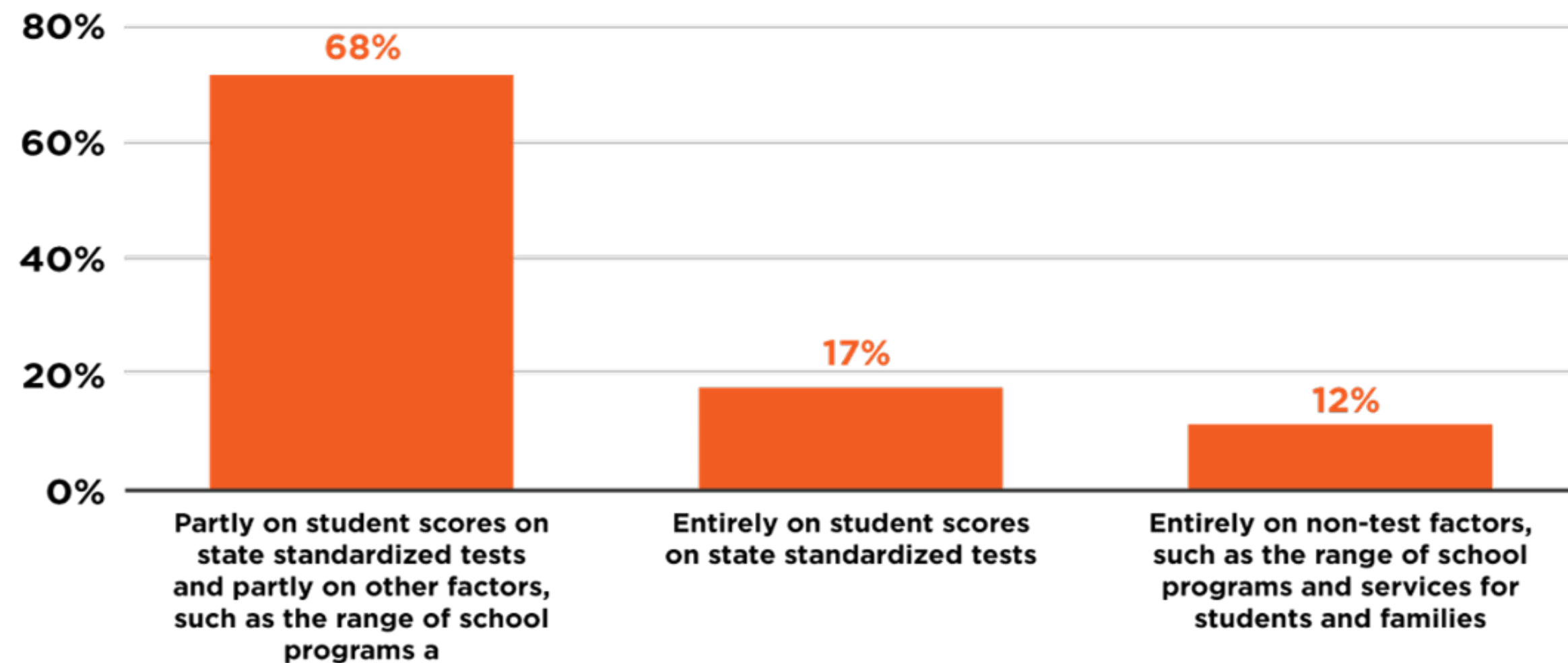
