Highlights of the 2022 Accountability System Ratings

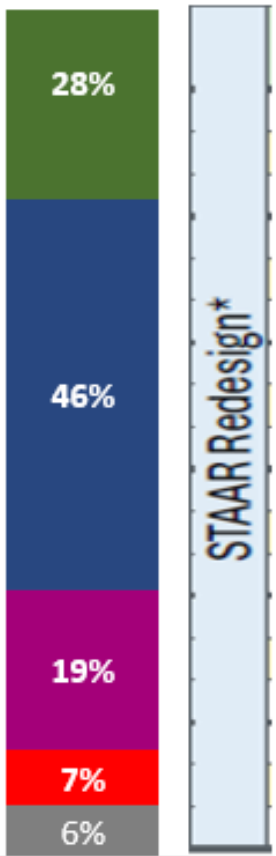
Campuses (including Open-Enrollment Charter Schools)

Of the 8,966 campuses in Texas, 8,449 were evaluated for ratings. Of the campuses considered for ratings 2,355 (27.9%) earned an A overall rating, 3,889 (46.0%) campuses earned a B overall rating, 1,637 (19.4%) earned a C overall rating, 561 (6.6%) campuses earned a Not Rated: Senate Bill 1365 overall rating and 7(0.1%) earned a Not Rated: Data Under Review. 517 campuses were labeled Not Rated.

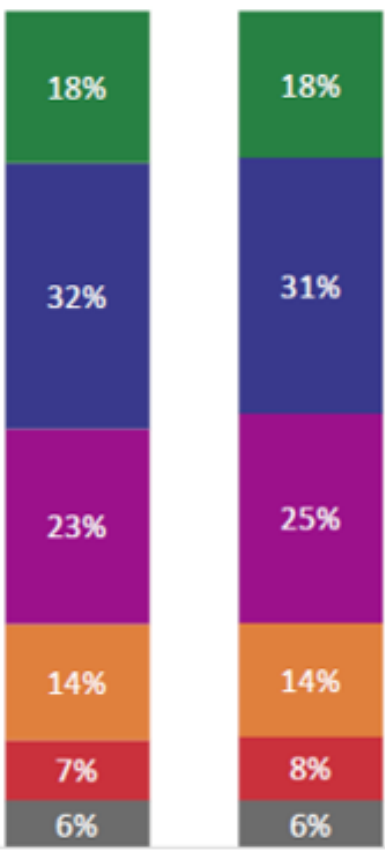

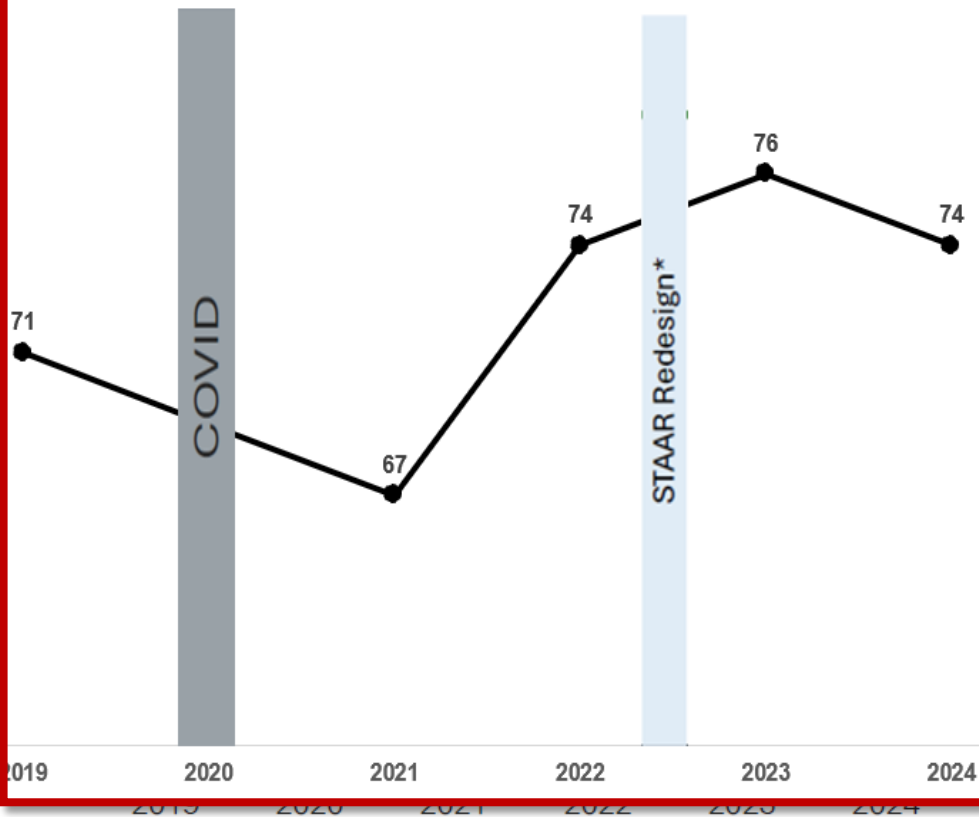
If 8,500 campuses receive a 2024 rating, then...

- 18% or 1,530 campuses receive an A; **825 fewer campuses than in 2022.**
- 31% or 2,635 campuses receive a B; **1,254 fewer campuses than in 2022.**

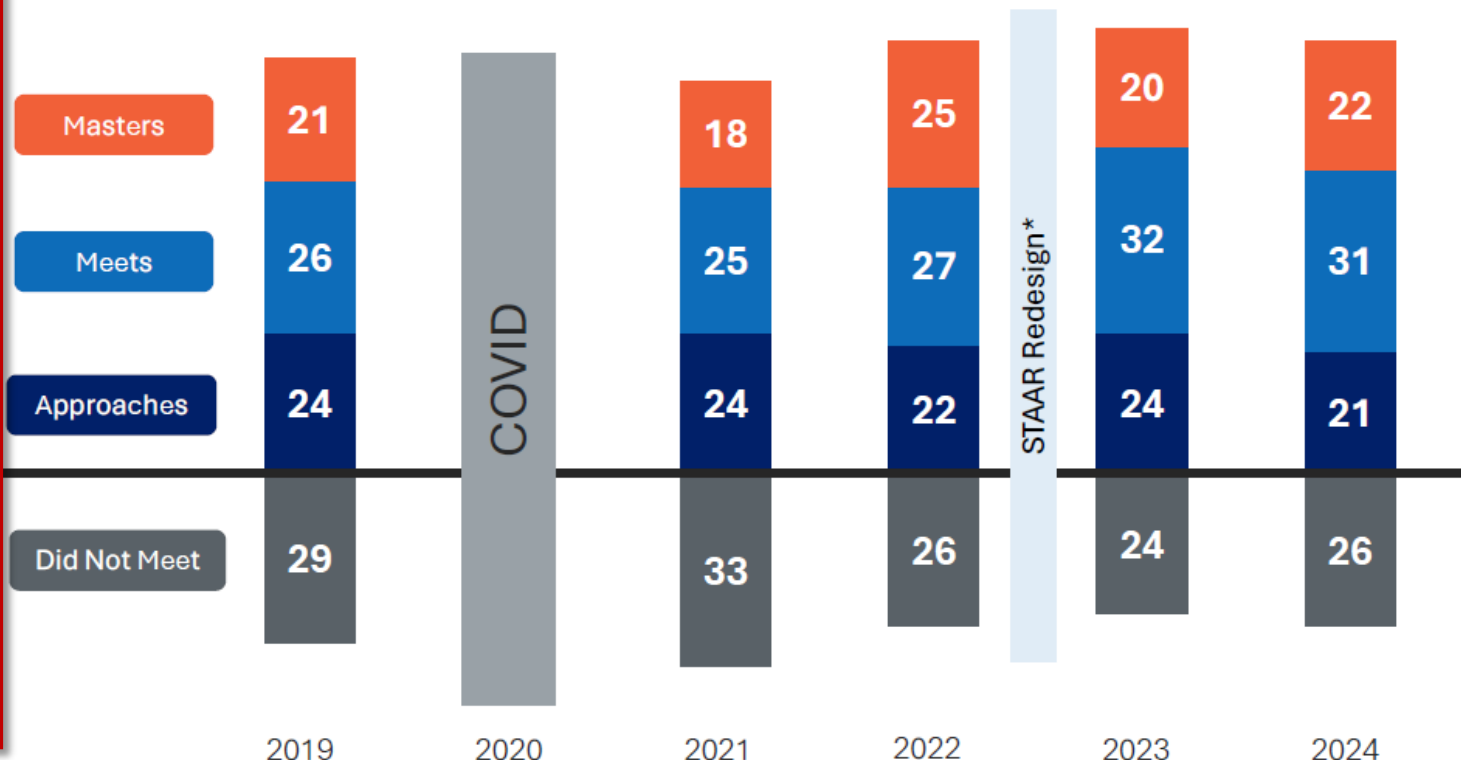
If 8,500 campuses receive a 2024 rating, then 22% or 1,870 campuses will receive a D or F rating. This is a **233% increase** from the 561 D/F campuses in 2022.

(Grades 3-8, English I & II)

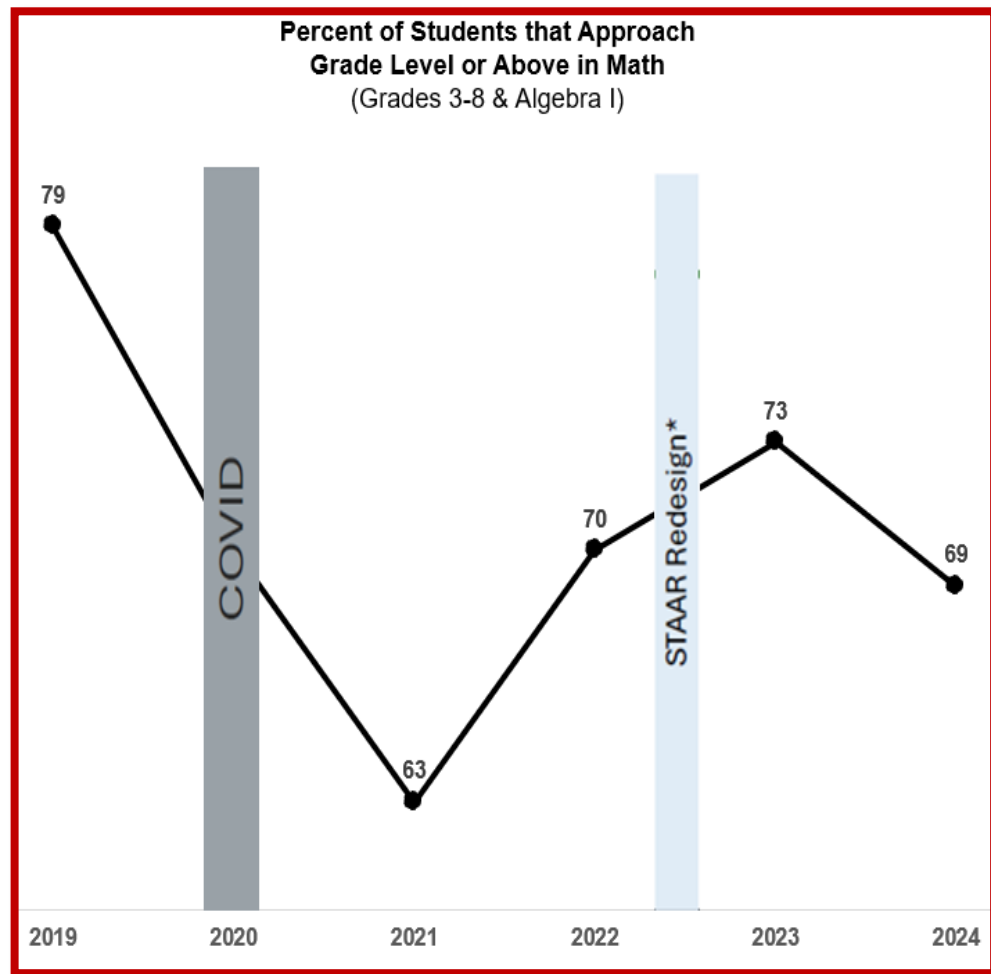

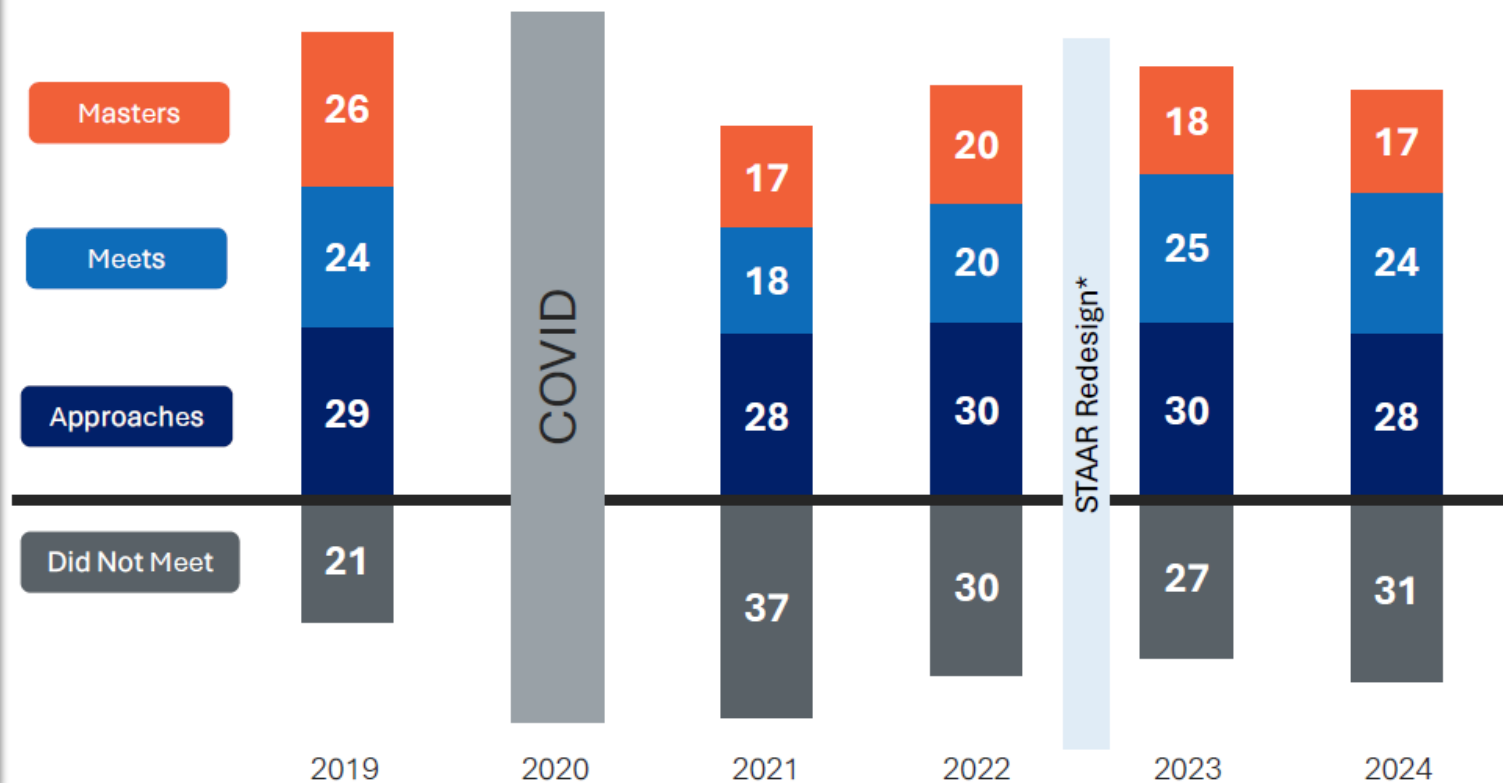

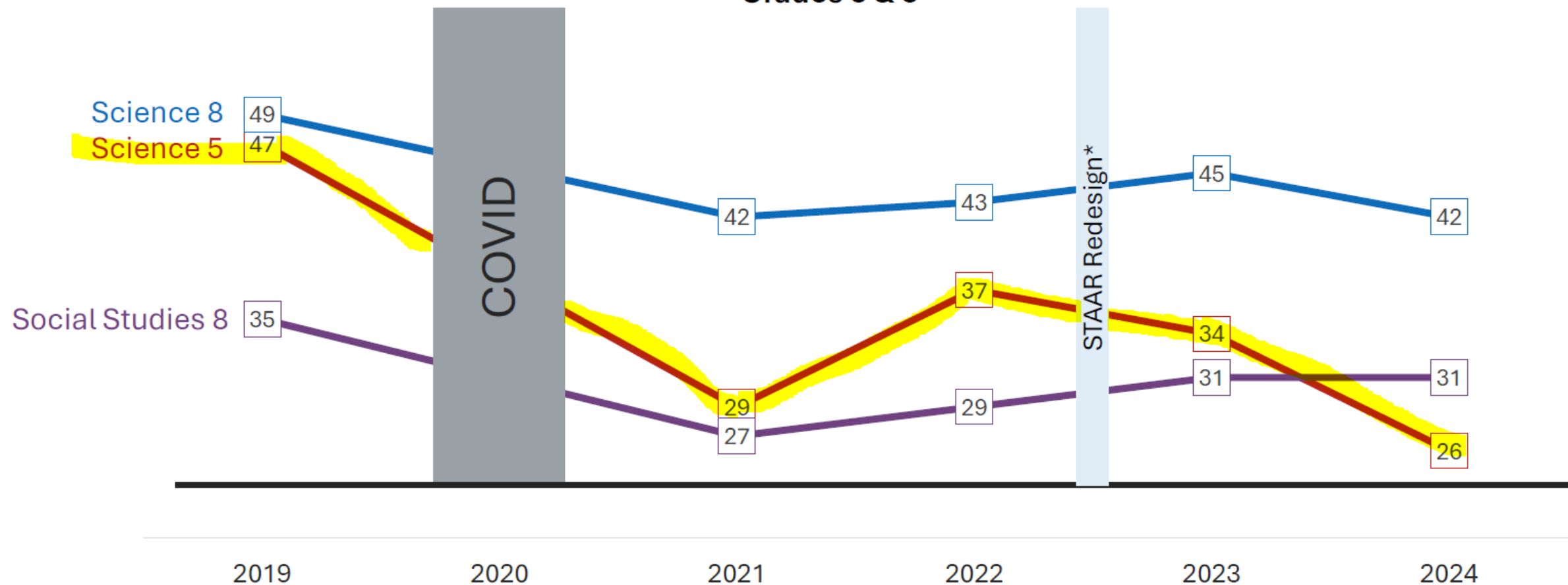

Science & Social Studies – Grades 5 & 8



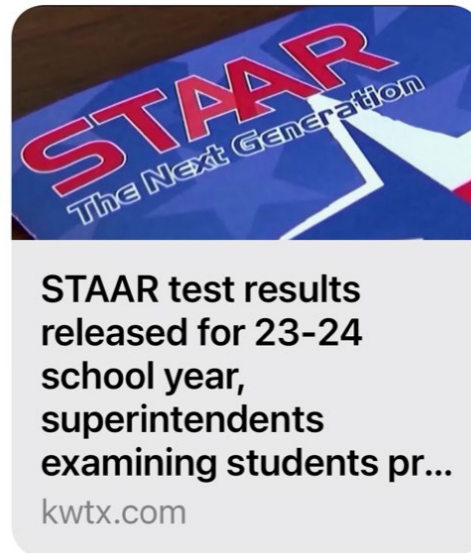
Percentage of Students Who Met Grade Level – Science and Social Studies

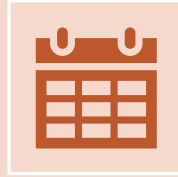

Unexpected Impacts

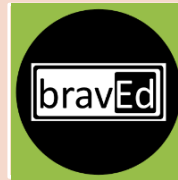
- Increase in ECR Zero scores impact not only Domain 1 scores but all Domain scores.
- Biggest negative impact: Appears to be in Domain 2A.
- One district calculated a 150% increase in D's and F's in Domain 2A from 2023 to 2024. (540% increase from 2022.)

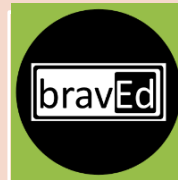
